2. ***Please note that Scholarship Forms are reviewed on a rolling basis. FILLING OUT THE APPLICATION DOES NOT GUARANTEE A SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE PROGRAM.***
3. No payment should be offered with the LandPaths' Summer Programs Scholarship Application Form.
4. If you have been awarded a scholarship we will let you know by May 22nd at the latest. Earlier applications may be responded to earlier.
5. If you are awarded a scholarship, you will be immediately mailed (or emailed) additional paperwork, including essential registration forms that must be filled out by a parent or guardian. Included in this packet will be an invoice for payment. **Confirmation by you, and Payment (or a payment plan) must be returned within one week of receiving your acceptance and paperwork.**
6. If you are awarded a scholarship, you must make your payment (or make a payment plan) immediately in order to reserve your spot. If no word from you is received within one week of receiving your acceptance paperwork, we may give your spot away to another youth.
7. Paperwork can be returned by one week prior to your program at the latest.
8. If you do not receive a scholarship, **Owl Camp ONLY** may have work trade opportunities available. Please be in touch if you are able to volunteer as a:
 - i. VAN DRIVER
Full trade for camp
Requires parent to drive the van from Bayer Farm to Camp each morning and afternoon for one full session.
 - ii. CAMP ASSISTANT
Partial to full trade available
Requires parent to volunteer for at least 3 full days at camp for one session.
